Kragenäs information pamphlet

During the summertime there are a lot of people staying at Kragenäs at the same time. To ensure everybody's comfort, we have some rules and regulations, which we would like to share with you.

ALCOHOL AND DRUGS

The Guides and Scouts of Sweden has a policy against the usage of alcohol and drugs during scouting activities. Therefore, our guests are not allowed to neither bring nor drink alcoholic beverages nor use any kinds of illegal drugs at the campsite.

ARRIVAL

THE BEACH

The beach at Kragenäs is public and is used regularly by our visitors and people living in the surrounding areas. Please beware of diving due to the tide.

CARS

Vehicles are not allowed pass the road barriers. Please use hand carts for transporting goods on the campsite. Vehicles with accessibility parking are permitted to pass our road barriers and park close to the sea by the beach.

COMPOSTING

All your compostable (biodegradable) waste must be recycled. There are hatches along the side of the lavatory facilities, which are designated for compostable waste.

DIGGING

Please avoid digging holes on our grounds and remember to fix the grounds before leaving Kragenäs. There are electric cables in the grounds. To avoid damages, do not put tent pegs more than 30 cm down in the ground. At Intendenturplan and parts of Lilla ängen, the limit is 20 cm.

FIRE

Safety comes first when making a fireplace and using it. When making your own fireplace, be careful and cause no damage to the ground. Furthermore, please remember to reset your fireplaces before leaving Kragenäs. There are designated fireplaces for campfires in the area.

For safety reasons, always store water close to the fire. If a fire ban is announced from the authorities, you will be informed about it. There are rules and regulations about fires at Kragenäs. Please ask for instructions when you have arrived to the campsite.

FIREWOOD

At Övre ängen there is a firewood storage. Use this firewood freely and fill the storage if it is empty. Please return and stack your unused firewood before you leave the campsite.



FOOD SERVICES

During some weeks in the summer (July 15 to July 30), Kragenäs scout center has extended its food services. For a small fee, every scout group can ease their stay and get all of their groceries delivered to the campsite. Breakfast, lunch, snacks, dinner and on some occasions a dessert are included.

INFORMATION

During your stay our staff will have an information meeting each evening. A troop leader from each group at the camp site should participate.

THE JETTY / THE PIER

There is a jetty on the beach that is owned by the municipality of Tanum and may be used for bathing freely by the public. Kragenäs scout center also has a boat pier that the public may use as well. If you are staying overnight with a boat at the pier, booking is mandatory.

KRAGENÄSARE

During the summertime, there are hosts at Kragenäs, called Kragenäsare. They are there to help you and make your time at Kragenäs easier. All of them have a light and dark blue scarf. If you are in need of assistance, please call +46(0)525 233 80.

THE KRAGENÄS KIOSK
